Dormant Judgment

ORC 2329.07 became effective 4-6-17

- Judgment good for 5 years unless a renewal activity occurs
- Judgment for the State of Ohio allows for the judgment to remain good for 10 years unless a renewable activity occurs
- Judgments can be revived (going through the revivor process) unless they have been dormant more than 10 years (Judgments granted after June 2004) or 21 years (Judgments granted prior to June 2004)
